Room Premium	The annual fund for compliant room premiums remains at £10 per room per week for all new placements. It is the Provider's responsibility to ensure that the room premium is applied for and set up at the time the placement is made. Should a Provider make a retrospective claim for room premiums, the maximum period the county council will backdate is the later of the compliant room start date or 3 months from the date the request is made
Out of County Placements	To avoid distorting prices in neighbouring council areas, the uplifts described in this report will not be applied to placements made outside of the county council's borders. Instead, the county council will honour the host authority uplifts, upon receipt of confirmation of the host authority uplift.
