3. What is your 2020/21 and 2021/22 Weekly Residential Fee Rate
4. What is your 2020/21 and 2021/22 Weekly Residential Dementia Fee Rate

Where you operate a base, lowest or starting rate please indicate aside each rate provided for clarity.

Where you do not use a base, lowest or starting rate, please provide an average rate for each care type and indicate aside each rate for clarity.

Where you operate banded/tier rates or have multiple, or a range of rates for each care type, please indicate as such and provide the rate bandings or ranges and a link or explanation to how these are applied.

5. Please state the annual uplift applied to the above rates in 2019/20 and 2020/21. If no set percentage was applied, please provide the average percentage applied to each care type.
